Intervention of KVK with quantitative data support

Mr Yogesh Vinod Malpande is rural youth of Jalgaon Jamod Dist.

since last 5-6 years. He is having 6 acres of rainfed land, growing crop like cotton, Soybean, Redgram but he was not satisfied with income getting from his land. During his visit to KVK he expressed his interest in subsidiary business like goat farming. He attended the vocational training in Sheep & Goat farming conducted by KVK during 2006-2007.

Training

During training programme all information about Goat farming like types of breeds of goat, their characteristics, care & management during rearing, feeding & watering, vaccination schedule, various diseases of goat & their control treatments are given to him. Also all participants are visited the demonstration unit of goat unit at KVK farm. In 2009-2010 he purchase 10 local goat & 1 buck from farmer nearby village & reared in available infrastructure on his farm. KVK suggested him to purchase the osmanabadi buck for breeding purpose. In 2009 he purchase osmanabadi buck from govt farm at Pohara Dist. Amravati. But unfortunately within 3 months the buck is dead due to attack of wild animal.

Demonstration

During 2010-11 KVK giving benefits of assessments in goat to him., to minimize the endoecto parasite infection in goat. He is in regular contact with KVK for many problems occurred in his farm throughout the year & discuss the KVK Scientist with his problem& fallowed suggestions given by KVK scientist on problem occurred. Field days, group meetings & Publicity & Marketing

During various programmes of KVK like Krishi melawa, Agri. Technological week, Field day, training, KVK gives publicity of his enterprise. KVK helps him for marketing of the bucks & unproductive female goat.

Timeline of entrepreneurship development of entrepreneur

After getting training from KVK, initially he started a small goat unit 10+1 in available infrastructure on his farm investing Rs. 20000/-. In 2 years number of goat increased to double. In current year after selling of unproductive goat and small bucks of one year, now he has maintain 10+1 goat unit.

Technical Component

For rearing of goat technical guidance is given by KVK. KVK scientist visits his farm regularly and give detail guidance about vaccinations and disease management.

Status of Entrepreneur before and after enterprise

Before starting of goat unit he was earning Rs.1.00 lakh per annum from his 6 acres of land, after starting small goat unit he is earning income Rs.10000-15000/- per year from it and his income from land is also increased due to use of manure and also his expenditure on fertilizer is reduced.

Present Working condition of Enterprise

Now a days he maintain 10+1 goat unit out of that 3 lactating doe, 4 pregnant doe & 3 kids, 1 buck in his unit. Last year he had sold 10 goat of average weight 20-25 kg @ Rs. 800-1000/- per animal from which he earned Rs. 22000/- against cost of production of Rs.8200/- where he earned Rs.13800/- extra benefits. Presently he is satisfied with his goat farming, now he has decided wide expansion of goat farming from his income.

Horizontal Spread

Inspiring from Mr. Y. V. Malpande small goat unit, his colleague has also started small goat unit under guidance of KVK. Another 3 small goat units will be started in nearby villages in our area.
