## KVK Dimapur successfully organised Kisan sammelan and release of 17<sup>th</sup> instalment of PM Kisan Scheme

The Kisan sammelan and release of 17<sup>th</sup> instalment of PM Kisan Scheme programme was successfully organised by KVK Dimapur on 18<sup>th</sup> June 2024. Dr. Phool Kumari, Sr. Scientist cum Head KVK Dimapur in her inaugural speech, welcomed the dignitaries and farmers. She also expressed her gratitude for selecting KVK Dimapur from Nagaland to launch the programme. Dr. Homeswar Khalita, Head, ICAR Nagaland centre spoke about the significance and usefulness of PM Kisan.
