Training and Motivation

Agriculture was the way of life for Smt. Nnole Thyu. She had been rearing livestock, poultry and cultivating various vegetable crops without much profit due to unscientific method of farming. After coming in contact with the extension functionaries of KVK Kohima and Agriculture department, she started learning the scientific method of farming and various technologies through trainings and demonstrations. Hence, her attitude was completely changed and further motivated to take agriculture as agri-business by adopting scientific method of farming and newer technologies to increase the production and productivity of the farm. She continues to attend training and demonstration programmes organized by KVK, Kohima and time to time receives advisory services rendered by experts from KVK and agri & allied departments.

Output and Outcome

Income was meager as the agricultural activity was merely for subsistence. However, with our interventions she was able to generate more income from all the units. The component of the mixed farming of Smt. Nnole Thyu under animal husbandry includes piggery, poultry and Rabbitry.
